Uses Jiu Jitsu like skill to design think emergence for social justice. Has evolved as a thought leader aka anti-hero.



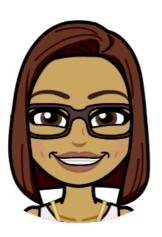
The Counsellor
